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OTHER METHODS:

Other methods for determining area and populations effected by a hazardous material release are the following; The Department of Transportation Emergency Response Guidebook (2012), and other Resource manuals; Computer Programs & Software, such as the following: E-Plan, CAMEO, ARCHIE, ALOHA, computer modeling; Facility input; CAT Team input.

These methods can be used for determining protective measures, isolation distance, local weather conditions and evacuation for specific chemicals.

The Everbridge Emergency Notification System can be used to provide Emergency Notification to the affected areas.

5. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS),
6. Chemical profiles,
7. Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) pages,
8. National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) codes,
9. Facility Risk Management Plans (RMPs).
